2) The Speaker, Deputy Speaker, and Leader of the Opposition are eligible for VIP Transport services. This transport service is invoiced to Parliamentary Service at a rate of \$171 per hour and disclosed at this rate. VIP Transport for Ministers is charged at \$68 per hour and disclosed at that rate. Contractors used by Parliamentary Service and Ministerial Services for transporting eligible members/Ministers are disclosed at the rate charged by the contractor. The variable hourly rates reflect Parliamentary Service's lower usage level and a different charging regime.
